인사말 **&** Greeting Words

안녕하십니까? 저는 이번 전시회를 공동주최한 미라클시티 갤러리 대표 권 영훈입니다.

오늘 이번 전시회를 찾아 주신 내빈 여러분과 참가한 작품의 국내외 작가 및 소장자 여러분께 우선 진심으로 감사드립니다.

우리가 살고 있는 현재는 AI(인공지능), 우주여행 등 다양한 미래 첨단 기술이 대부분의 산업영역을 주도하고 있지만, 그러한 발달에는 인간의 정신적인 안정적 바탕이 큰 역할을 해왔다는 것은 이미 많은 지식인들이 말해왔습니다. 그러한 역할에 미술품은 단연 으뜸이라고 생각합니다.

현재 세계적으로 문화예술에 대한 중요성이 부각되는 시점에서 우리도 미술에 대한 창조적인 도전이 필요하다고 판단합니다. 저는 오랫동안 미술계에 몸담고 있는 사람으로서 우리가 우리 미술을 능동적으로 또한 선도적으로 부흥시키는데 필요한 몇가지 말씀을 드리고자 합니다.

첫째는 우리 스스로가 미술계의 세계 진출에 적극 동참하여야 합니다.

현재 한국 작가들의 작품들이 세계시장에서의 제대로 평가를 받고 있는지 또한 기회가 있는지에 대하여 생각해 봅니다. 우리가 많은 기회와 공정한 시장 평가를 받으려면 작가들 개인의 역량도 필요하지만 우리 모두가 미술작품에 대한 애정이 표출되어야 합니다.

작은 예로 중국에서는 오래전부터 세계적인 미술관을 방문하는 수천만원의 고급 유럽여행투어도 있고, 음악회를 참관하는 투어도 있습니다. 그러한 방문들이 유렵, 미국의 관계자들에게는 점차 중국인의 예술에 대한 수준이 높아지고 있다고 비추어지고, 따라서 중국 예술품을 시장에서 찾고 또한 가치도 높게 평가받고 있다고 봅니다.

둘째는 K-Art시대를 위한 손쉬운 접근과 예술활동 방안을 위해 정부와 우리가 노력해야 합니다. 이미 K-Pop, K-Drama, K-Movie 등 다양한 분야에서 세계적인 두각을 나타내고 있습니다. 우리미술도 그렇게 할 수 있다고 믿습니다. 특히, 정부의 적극적인 지원이 필요하며 여기에는 신진작가들의 노출, 기회제공, 작품 활동에 필요한 경제적 지원, 국가 차원의 미술품 구매 및 판매 간소화제도 방안 연구가 필요합니다.

마지막으로 미술품의 재테크 기회를 작가와 소장자 그리고 구매자 모두에게 제공하여야 합니다. 이렇게 하기 위하여는 지속적인 전시회 개최를 통한 좋은 작품에 접할 수 있는 기회가 있어야하며, 미술작품에 대한 공식적인 감정을 받기 쉽게 만들어야 하는데 정부의 결단이 필요합니다. 그렇게 되면 거래가 활성화되고, 작가들은 미술에 전념할 수 있는 기회를 갖게 되고, 미술 소장가들은 본격적인 미술품 재테크시대에 참여하게 되는 것입니다.

다시한번 관계자 여러분 모두에게 주최자로서 감사 말씀을 드립니다.

또한, 미래의 미술계는 사치라는 인식에서 벗어나 국민 모두가 정서적으로 즐기고 또한 국가에 기여하는 역할을 해야 합니다. 이러한 차원에서 중동의 부자 국가인 아랍에미레이트가 프랑스 정부에 12억 7천만 달러(약1조 4천억 원)를 지불하면서 수도 아부다비에 〈루브르 아부다비 - Louvre Abu Dhabi - 박물관〉을 2017년에 개관한 것을 눈여겨보아야 합니다.

즉, 석유부국에서 예술부국, 관광부국으로 다시 태어나겠다는 것이 정부의 취지였습니다.

자랑스러운 문화민족인 우리도 어느 나라 못지않은 깊은 잠재력을 가지고 있습니다. 이번 전시회가 우리 모두 생각과 노력을 합하여 그러한 잠재력이 활짝 꽃피우도록 하는 새로운 출발점이 되기를 희망합니다.

인간이 보고 느끼고 생각하는 바를 가장 꾸밈없이 보여주는 것이 그림과 조각과 같은 예술작품인 것 같습니다. 자연의 일부인 인간 육체의 아름다움, 자연 속에서 유유자적하거나 자연에서 생명력을 얻는 인간의 모습, 자연 자체의 아름다움, 그리고 이를 바라보는 우리의 느낌과 생각을 과연 예술작품이 아닌 글이나 말이 얼마나 실감나게 표현할 수 있을까요? 그런 의미에서 생명의 원천인 자연과 환경의 중요성과 아름다움을 가장 쉽고 강렬하게 전달할 수 있는 것이 바로 예술이라고 생각합니다. 문화예술이야말로 마음의 양식입니다. 표현 수단으로서만이 아니라 예술은 인류를 하나의 가족으로 묶어주고, 인간의 터전을 자연을 닮은 아름다운 공간으로 가꾸어 줍니다.

이번 행사를 관통하는 주제는 '환경'입니다. 산업혁명 이후 지구가 계속해서 더워지는 온난화가 초래하는 기상 재난은 열악한 조건에 놓인 사람들의 삶을 송두리째 앗아가곤 합니다. 인간이 남용한 플라스틱이 제대로 처리되지 않고 강과 바다로 흘러들어 야생동물의 생명을 해치고, 시간이 지나 잘게 부스러진 플라스틱은 생태계를 돌아인간의 건강을 위협하기에 이르렀습니다. 산하를 마구 훼손하여 자연 본래의 모습을 없애고 야생 생물들의 보금 자리를 빼앗습니다. 그 결과 자연 속에 있던 바이러스가 인간 세계까지 옮겨와 인간의 행동을 구속하고 있습니다. 코로나가 그렇습니다. 모든 게 인간의 이기심 때문입니다. 치유와 화해가 절실히 필요한 때입니다.

이번 행사가 코로나로 지친 우리의 마음을 어루만지고, 새로운 희망을 꿈꿀 수 있도록 도와줄 것이라 기대합니다. 환경을 지키지 않으면 인간 삶도 존재할 수 없다는 자각을 일깨울 것 또한 희망합니다. 참관객들께서도 새로운 영감과 활력을 얻기를 희망합니다.

이런 의미에서 '녹녹녹-綠綠綠-Knock Knock Knock'은 매우 시의적절한 울림입니다.



While waiting to meet you during the festival, I will take some time to meditate on the words of Vincent van Gogh:




























